

Call for application

Within the framework of the Pannónia Scholarship Programme, the University of Miskolc announces a call for application for student mobilities to be completed in the academic year 2024/2025.

Application deadline: continuous until the funds are exhausted, depends on the partner institutions acceptance of the mobility request

For self-paying students:

Types of student mobility (undergraduate, masters, postgraduate, doctoral level):

- Long-term mobility for studies (2-12 months)
- Long-term mobility for traineeship (2-12 months)
- Long-term mobility for research (2-3 months) **PhD students and students of one-tier programmes with a minimum of 7 completed semesters**
- Long-term traineeship for recent graduates (2-12 months)

For all students (including SH, SCYP students for max 10 days)

- Short-term mobility for studies (2-30 days)
- Short-term mobility for research (2-30 days) only for Master, PhD students and students of one-tier programmes with a minimum of 7 completed semesters
- Traineeship for recent graduates (2-12 months)

Application requirements:

- Minimum two completed semesters. Exception: mobility for research purposes
- Master and PhD students, students of one-tier programmes with a minimum of 7 completed semesters are eligible to apply for mobility for research with the Recommendation Letter of the supervisor
- Students must be active students during both the application and mobility periods. Exception: Internships for recent graduates
- For recent graduates, active student status is required at the time of application

Application process

Students can apply for the Pannonia Program by filling out the [Online Application form](#) with the certificate of active student status and the fully signed Learning or Mobility agreement:

- **Learning Agreement** for mobility for studies
- **Mobility Agreement** for traineeship and research

Credit transfer:

The activities completed during the mobility must be recognised by the sending institution and fully comply with the structure of the curriculum on a proportional basis to the duration of the student's mobility.

Partner institutions:

Pannonia mobility can be realized under any bilateral agreement (Pannonia, Erasmus+, MoU), if the partner accepts the student mobility with the Pannonia Learning or Mobility Agreement document.

The Pannonia bilateral agreements are in the process of being signed with the current partner institutions, the regularly updated list is available from the application form.
